

NAVIGATING THE BURN PIT REGISTRY FOR VETERANS



Purpose of the Burn Pit Registry: OEF/OIF/OND/OFS Veterans and Service members who have deployed to the Southwest Asia theater of operations on or after August 2, 1990 as well as those who have deployed to Afghanistan or Djibouti after September 11, 2001 can use the registry questionnaire to report exposures to airborne hazards (such as smoke from burn pits, oil-well fires, or pollution during deployment), as well as other exposures and health concerns. The registry also offers a snapshot of your deployment health that can be printed and used for guidance with VA Providers

Is this for me?

- The registry is a database of information about Veterans and Servicemembers collected through a questionnaire.

Why sign up?

- Create a snapshot from which to identify changes in your health.
- Print and use your completed questionnaire to discuss concerns with your provider.
- Learn about follow-up care and VA benefits.
- Instructions are available if you need assistance with the questionnaire.

Sign up in 3 easy steps

1. Use your **Premium DS Logon Level 2** account to access the questionnaire. You must have a **Premium DS Logon Level 2** account to participate.
2. Complete entire questionnaire and submit.
3. Print or save your completed questionnaire for your records.

You can either sign up for a DS Logon or use your log-in for "MyHealtheVet", TRICARE or you can use your DoD Common Access Card (CAC) if still active duty/reserves.



DS LOGON Registration Procedures

This registration is a 10-step process to assist an individual in creating a DS Logon account. This process can take up to 10 minutes to verify your identity. Individuals will be consenting to a soft-inquiry on their credit reports and receive a one-time PIN to the phone number on file. Prior to starting this, please ensure you have time and access to your phone.

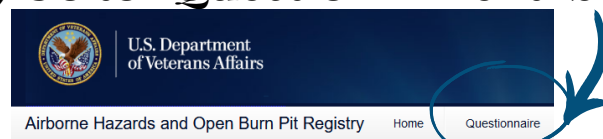

- Once you submit you **CANNOT** go back and change your answers.
- Don't dig yourself into a hole, meaning it will ask you about your smoking history, civilian jobs and hobbies in attempt to 'pass the buck' off on something you did or are doing. Be advised.
